







<div>English</div> <div><div>Orion and the Dark</div><div>We will read the story together, map it out and create actions to help us internalise the story. We are going to develop positive attitudes towards writing by planning and producing our own stories based on a similar topic. We will learn how to use both familiar and unfamiliar punctuation correctly inc: full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks and commas for lists.</div><div>A first Poetry Book</div><div>We hope to develop our pleasure in reading, motivation to read and understanding by listening to, discussing and expressing views about poems. We will recognise simple recurring literary language in poetry, discuss our favourite words and phrases and continuing to build up a repertoire of poems learnt by heart. We will then have a go at creating our own individual poems.</div><div></div></div>	<div>PSHE</div> <div><div>Changes - we will look at how we can support each other through changes and how they make us feel. We will learn about the people in our communities who help us and who to turn to if we need support.</div><div></div></div>	<div>Maths</div> <div><div>We will begin this term by looking at <b>Number Sense</b>. We will focus on the place value of each digit and having a true understanding of what the numbers represent. We will look at different ways to make and show numbers and the range of tools and images we can use to support our mathematical learning.</div><div>After this we will be exploring <b>Additive Reasoning</b> where we will have a focus on addition and subtraction of 1 and 2 digit numbers. We will look at different strategies and tools to use and how to explain our findings.</div><div></div></div>	
<div>Computing</div> <div><div>We will be working with Hector's World focusing on how to stay safe online and what to do if something makes us feel uncomfortable.</div></div>	<div>PE</div> <div><div>The children will work with TUFC completing team games and working on multi skills.</div><div></div></div>	<div>Healthy Heroes.</div> <div><div>Year 2 Learning Experience Autumn 1 5.9.18 - 19.10.18</div></div>	<div>ART /DESIGN TECHNOLOGY</div> <div><div>We will design and create posters and collages about Healthy Heroes. We will be exploring fruit and vegetables and using them to create art - through printing. We will experiment with different flavours making healthy smoothies / salads to eat and drink.</div><div></div></div>
<div>Science</div> <div><div>We will be noticing that animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. We will find out about and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air). We will also describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.</div></div>	<div>Outcome: We will be creating giant collages of 'People Who Help Us' for display and artistic interpretations of people using fruit and vegetable prints.</div>	<div>RE</div> <div><div>Creation: We will be learning about the creation of God's world and how we need to care for it. We will learn about Noah's Ark, why God chose to send a flood and his promise not to do it again.</div><div>Prayers, Feasts and Saints: We will learn all about the Rosary and its significance in the Catholic faith. We will be introduced to the prophet Samuel and will explore the parable of Jesus turning the water into wine.</div></div>
