Dear Parents / Carers

Next Friday 14th June is our whole school Sports day. Children and staff from Holy Angels will also be joining us.

All the children will be taking part and competing on behalf of their houses. All PE kits will be sent home on Wednesday 12th June so that the children can wear their PE kits **to school** on the Friday. PE kits should consist of a white polo shirt, black shorts and black plimsolls or trainers (any colour). Children may also wear their school jumper or cardigan. If you are worried that your child may be cold, please pack additional items such as tracksuit trousers as necessary, but please ensure that these are labelled with your child's name.

Children from Y1 - Y6 will be outside from 9.00 -1.00 p.m. Please ensure that sunscreen is applied before school and that they bring a suitable hat and water bottle to stay safe in the sun. A small number of children in the school have additional medical needs and staff will ensure that these children receive as little exposure to the sun as possible. Please let your child's class teacher know if you have additional concerns that you would like us to be aware of.

If your child would like to have their face painted in their team colours, staff will be available on the playground to do this from 8.30 a.m. onwards. Children should come and line up for face painting before going in to school. Parents are invited to stay on and have lunch with their children at 12.00 p.m. Please bring a picnic and a blanket. The PTA will also be selling bacon rolls at lunch time as well as serving teas and coffees throughout the morning.

If the weather is very wet we may have to cancel the day. In the event of this we will send a text to all parents at 7.30 a.m. and children should come to school in their school uniform. The event will be rescheduled for the morning of Tuesday 18th June.

The day promises to be very exciting and we look forward to seeing as many of you as possible!
