# Uniform Reminders

If you will be buying new uniform for your child over the Summer holidays please note the following reminders:

- All children from Y1 upwards should wear a white shirt with a collar and a tie.
- Trousers and skirts must be grey - stretchy fabrics are not permitted.
- Pinafore dresses are only permitted for girls in Y2 and below.
- School jumpers and cardigans should have a school logo and blue stripe.
- Boots and trainers are not permitted - shoes should be black.
- Socks and tights should be grey.
- Polo shirts are only for Reception children.

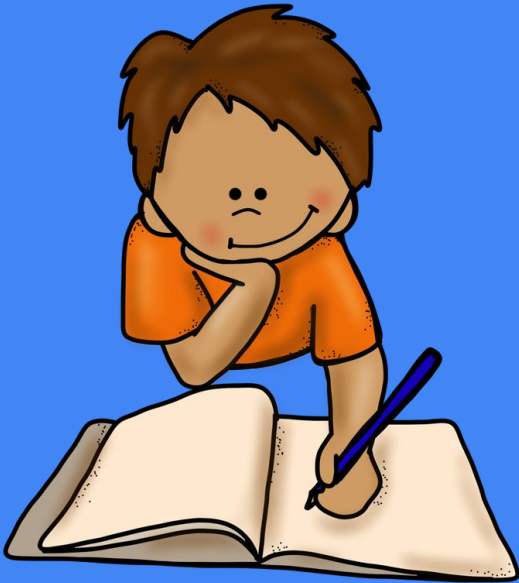

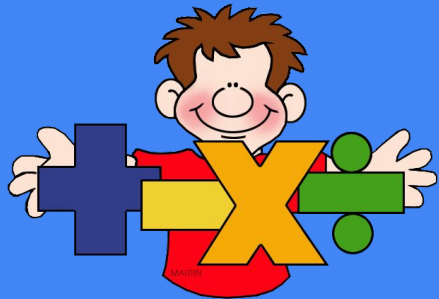

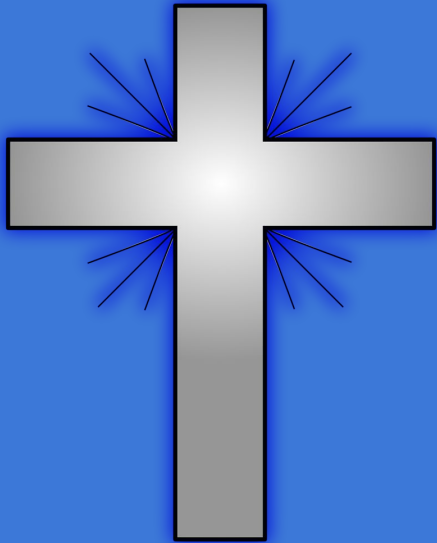
Dear Lord,
