Year R Applications to Primary Schools

If your child was born between 1st September 2015 and 31st August 2016 you will need to apply for a place for them at primary school. <u>The application period is from the 1st November to 15th January 2020.</u>

Parents can apply online or using a paper form available in the school office or by phoning Torbay Council student services on 01803 208908.

Please remember to sign your child in at the office if they are brought to school after 9.00a.m.






Week ending 11th October 2019
