Year 4 trip to Buckland Abbey



On Tuesday last week, Year 4 had the wonderful opportunity to go to Buckland Abbey in Yelverton.

This house was owned, and lived in by Francis Drake - our topic focus this term. The Abbey is now run as a National Trust visiting centre, and houses some incredible artefacts like the 'lost mould' used for 2 of Francis Drake's bronze statues.

We enjoyed walking around and seeing all of the things related to Francis Drake. In particular, a class favourite was looking at the Tudor artefacts - from laundry tongs to bread, from smelling salts to shoes with no left and right - it was here that we learned where phrases used today such as 'upper crust' and '3 square meals a day' come from!

We also had the opportunity to try on some replica Tudor Clothing and learned about the Sumptuary Laws.

Other class favourites were the huge barn and the coat of arms in the house. We also got to enjoy a painted map with lots of hidden information about Drake!

Spare forms can be collected from the office.




EASTER PASSION PLAY
