Government guidance


The government has announced that, as of Monday 14 December 2020, the self-isolation period for contacts of people with confirmed coronavirus will be shortened from 14 to 10 days. This change will apply to all those who are currently self-isolating including those who commenced self-isolation before Monday. The change reflects new evidence showing that people are most infectious around the time they first develop symptoms. By day 10, only 2% will still be capable of passing on the virus to others. People who test positive should continue to self-isolate for 10 days from onset of symptoms or 10 days from point of taking a positive test if asymptomatic.

School Meals

Payment and ordering of meals is via the Sims Pay system . The cost of a meal is £2.30. One account links to all your children attending the school. Parents should order their child's lunches and make payment by Saturday for the forthcoming week.

The kitchen manager cooks to order and so late requests for meals cannot always be the child's first choice of meal. <u>If you know your child will be late to</u> <u>school and you have forgotten to pre-order a lunch please contact the school</u> <u>by 9.15a.m. or provide a packed lunch.</u>



Attendance Reminders

If your child is sick please ring on the first day of absence by 9.15 a.m. and every other day thereafter. If you don't do this we will ring you as we are required to check on the welfare of our pupils. You MUST tell us if your child has CoronaVirus symptoms.

Evidence of all medical appointments must be provided.
