Dear Parents and Carers

Year 5 City & Culture Residential trip to Cardiff

I am pleased to tell you that we have booked a Year 5 residential trip to Cardiff for Wednesday 27 February Friday 1 March. The trip offers an enjoyable and intensely exciting learning experience as well as the opportunity to develop each child's independence and self-organisational skills. We do hope that your child will be able to join us.

We have done our best to keep the cost of the trip as low as possible at **£150**. This includes 2 nights' accommodation, meals and snacks (children will need to bring a packed lunch on the first day), transport to and from school, and all tickets and entrance fees. Please see the itinerary below. The children will be accompanied by at least four school staff members.

The school has been assigned its own accommodation in two dormitories – one for boys and one for girls at the YHA Cardiff Central. Adults will be accommodated in separate but adjacent rooms. Further information regarding the hostel can be found at www.yha.org.uk/hostel/yha-cardiff-central

An information session to answer any queries you may have about the trip will be held after school on **Friday 30 November** in Y5. If you have any questions but are unable to attend the session, please request a phone call via Mrs Gale in the office or speak to Mrs Saunders directly.

To secure your child's place on the trip a deposit payment of £25 is required by the **10 December**. Please note this deposit payment is paid straight to the theatre and youth hostel, and therefore is **non**-**refundable in any circumstances**. Monthly payments are then required to ensure that the total sum is paid well in advance of the trip. Payments can be made by cheque (made payable to Our Lady of the Angels) or cash. These should be sent in to school in a sealed envelope clearly marked 'Cardiff City & Culture' with your child's name and class. A payment card will be provided to assist you in keeping track of how much you have paid.

The school will fund the complete cost of the trip for any children that are currently in receipt of Free School Meals but the attached form must be completed and returned by 10 December to secure a place.
