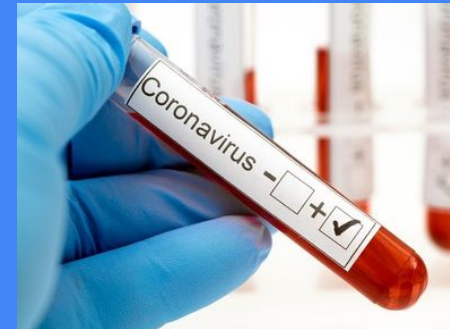

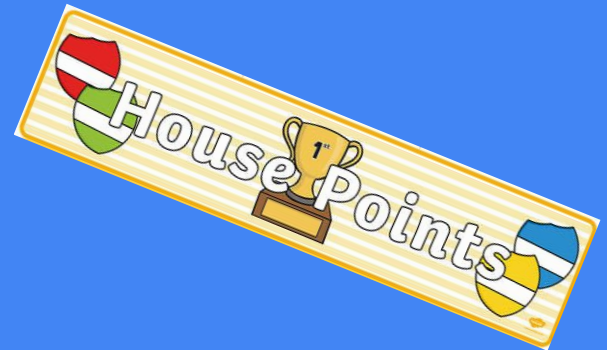

Please remember to sign your child in at the office if they are brought to school after 8.50 a.m.



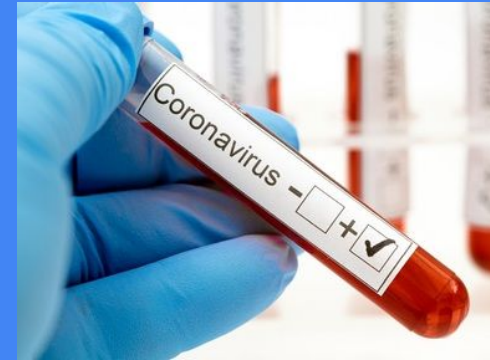

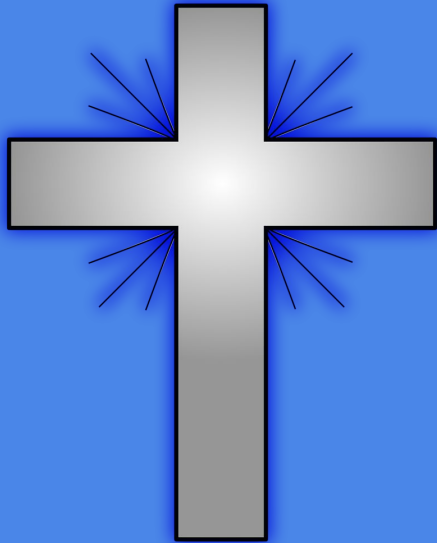
