Dear Parents / Carers

I am extremely pleased to announce the launch of the Read Write Inc. (Reception - Y3) and the Accelerated Reader (Y2 - Y6) reading schemes. These schemes have been proven nationally to improve outcomes for reading. They will be introduced to the children next week. Please note as part of the Accelerated Reader Scheme children will not be able to change their books until they have completed an electronic quiz which can only be completed at school.

We are planning to hold an information sessions for parents on Thursday at 2.15 p.m. for Read Write Inc and 2.45 p.m. for Accelerated Reader so please pop into the Community Room if you would like to learn more about them.
