Dear Parents / Carers

This week we have undertaken a Teaching and Learning review with a particular focus on writing. This was led by Matthew Barnes - the Deputy Director of Education and Standards from Plymouth CAST. He is a former Inspector of education (HMI) and has vast experience of inspecting schools for Ofsted. I am delighted to inform you that his report is overwhelmingly positive and reflects the hard work and dedication of our teaching staff. Although the report is not able to be externally published, he gave me permission to share some quotes from the report with you.

> "The Interim Head Teacher and other leaders have had a strong impact on the quality of the teaching of writing...the overall progress of pupils in writing has been markedly improved."

"The quality of teaching seen on the day was sound. In some areas it was strong. Lessons were purposeful. Strong relationships between staff and pupils allow teachers to challenge pupils. Clear evidence of planning to meet the needs of different pupils could be seen, including specific provision for pupils who have SEND." "The teaching of phonics is more effective than it used to be... adults are well trained and deliver phonics teaching that is punchy, engaging and helps pupils to make good progress." "Pupils' presentation is much better than it used to be. They show much greater stamina in their writing."

"Children (in the Foundation Stage) were seen participating in a range of useful self-selected activities during a free-flow lesson. Pleasingly, the children sustained their interest in the activities they had chosen to do. The quality of the enabling environment and use of assessment ensured that the activities were appropriate to capture children's interest and build on what they can do."

If you bring your child in to school outside of the registration periods you MUST come to the office to sign them in to school.




