Mount Everest	Mount Everest, the highest mountain in the world is on the border of Chinese Tibet and Nepal and
8848 metres tall	is part of the Himalayas mountain range. The Himalayas stretch 2,400km from east to west, across Bhutan, Nepal, India, Tibet, China, Pakistan, and Afghanistan
Gobi Desert	The Gobi Desert is the 5th largest desert in the world. Spanning, I.3million, km² is avast, arid region in northern China and southern Mongolia known for its dunes, mountains and rare animals such Bactrian camels.
Yangtze River	The Yangtze River is the fourth longest river in the world, which reaches 5,797km (3,602 miles) in length. China also has the sixth longest, the Yellow River, stretching 4,667km (2,900 miles).

The Great Wall of China	Built across the northern borders of China, this 21,196km wall was built to protect Chinese empires from various nomadic groups. It was thought to be built over 200 years from 771 BC - 476BC.
Forbidden City	Beijing's most famous tourist attraction is the Forbidden City—where China's emperors held court for 500 years from the 15 th century until 1911.
Qin Shihuang Mausoleum,	The Terracotta Army is a part of a massive burial tomb built for Emperor Qin Shi Huang, the first emperor of China. There are over 8,000 life size statues of soldiers buried along with the emperor.
