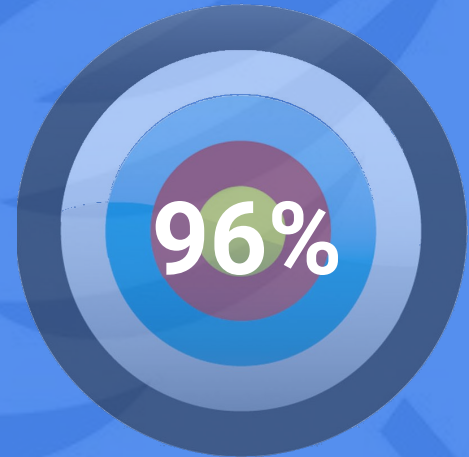

School Meals

The cost of a school meal is currently £2.65.

Please note that parents whose children are entitled to Free school meals or universal infant free school meals must also order their children's lunches in advance.

Holy Angels After school Club



If you require an After school club place for your child in Holy Angels Pre-school, it is important that you book them in prior to your child arriving at the pre-school door. After School club has a maximum number of children it can accept and there are occasions when it has been full and places are not available. Also, for your child's safety, it is important that Pre-school know to expect your child.

Further to the above, please let the school know if you have booked your child into After School club at Holy Angels Pre-school. Again, for their safety we need to know where the children are going at the end of each day.

Holy Angels After school Club



Although Holy Angels Pre-school closes on Friday 19th July, after our leavers zoo trip and presentation, we will still be offering Breakfast club to pupils from Our Lady of the Angels on Monday 22nd, Tuesday 23rd and Wednesday 24th July and after school on Friday 19th, Monday 22nd and Tuesday 23rd July. After school club will **NOT** be available on the last day of term Wednesday 24th.

However, these sessions **MUST** be booked **before Thursday 18th July**. We will **NOT** be taking ad-hoc bookings after the 18th July.

All invoices up until the end of term, Wednesday 24th July, will be sent out on Friday 19th July, we request prompt payment please.

As from September 2024, Our Lady of the Angels breakfast club fees will increase to £6.00 from 7.30 - 8.35am, after school club will remain £9.00 from 3.15pm - 5.30pm, or £3.00 if a child is collected before 3.45pm.
