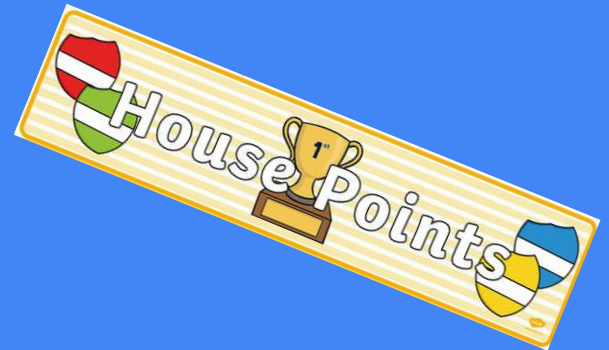

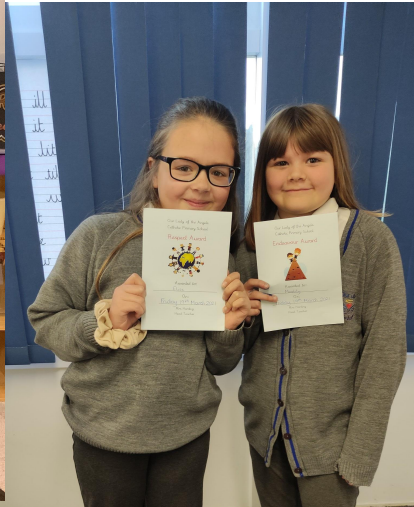

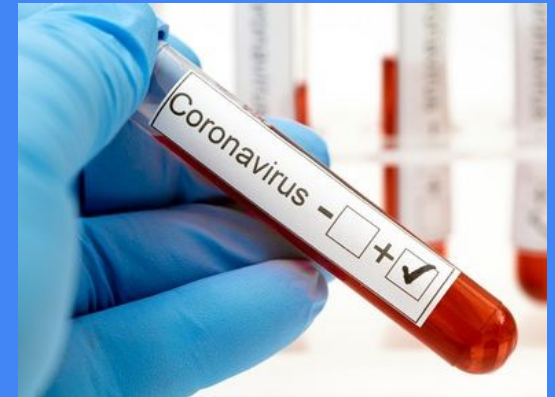
LFT testing at home

We have received the following advice;

If a person has two void tests they need to isolate and book a PCR test.

The home test kits state **“Do not leave the test to develop for longer than 30 minutes as this will make the result void.”**

If an LFD test is read after the 30 minute test window, it is noted that the device reads as positive. This is because the void line is added to the negative line, which then appears as a positive.





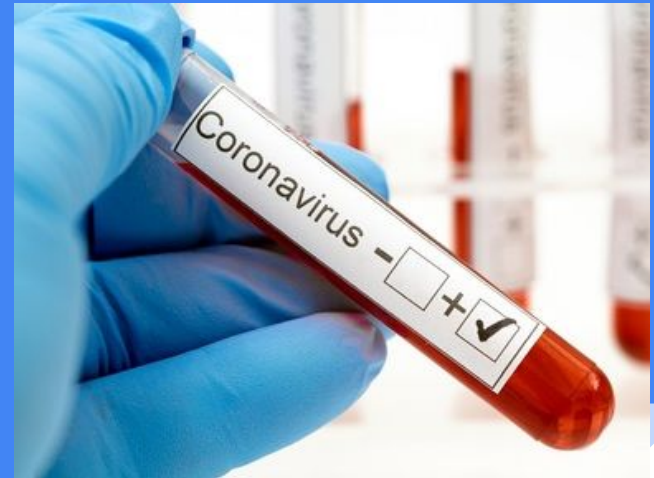

Payment and ordering of meals is via the Sims Pay system . The cost of a meal is £2.30. One account links to all your children attending the school. Parents should order their child's lunches and make payment in advance (by Saturday for the forthcoming week).

The kitchen manager cooks to order and so late requests for meals cannot always be the child's first choice of meal. If you know your child will be late to school and you have forgotten to pre-order a lunch please contact the school by 9.15a.m. or provide a packed lunch.

A reminder of our strength even in the face of fear.





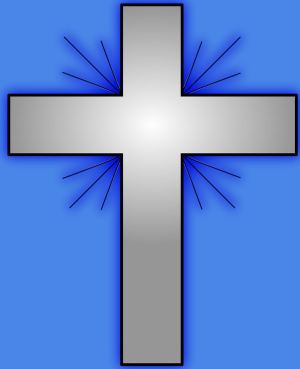
