If your child was born between 1st September 2010 and 31st August 2011 you will need to apply for a secondary school place. The application period is open from **1 September 2021 until 31st October 2021**.

The preferred method of application is online via the Citizen's Portal. This can be found at www.torbay.gov.uk/schools-and-learning/admissions/secondary-place-2022/ The portal will open on 1st September and will close at 23.59pm on 31st October 2021. Late applications, those made after this time, will be at a disadvantage.

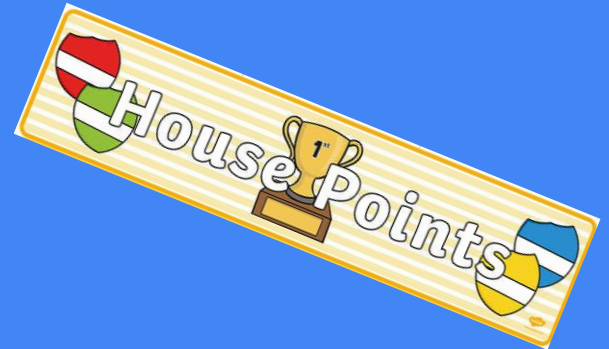

We would also recommend that you wear a face covering whilst waiting on the pavement outside the school when dropping off and picking up your child(ren).





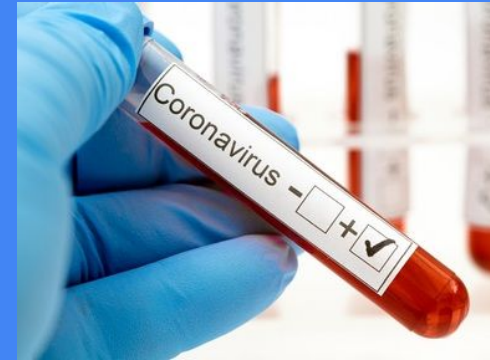

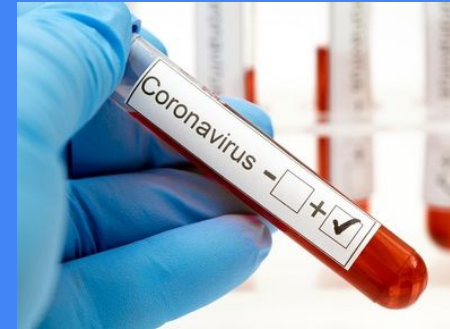

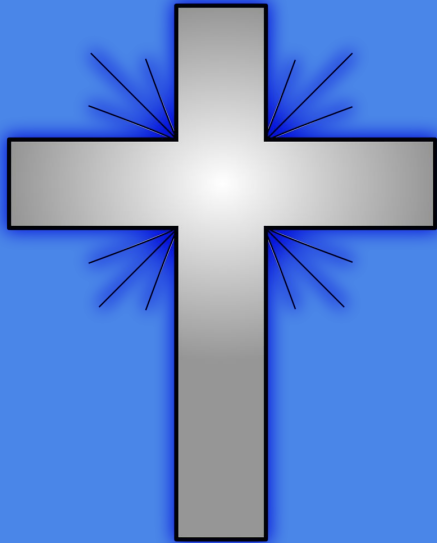
