Parking

You will have heard the very tragic news that a secondary school child was knocked down in Queensway last week and suffered serious injuries. I am sure that you will agree that we all need to work together to prevent another accident from happening. At times, people park selfishly around the school which puts the children in our community in dangerous situations. The Highway code sets out what is and is not legal - but more importantly - how to park safely and prevent harm to others.



It is not safe and therefore <u>illegal</u> to stop or park: (Highway Code Rule 243)

- On double yellow lines opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction
 - On zig-zags outside a school or near a school entrance
 - Anywhere that would prevent access for emergency services
 - Over a dropped kerb
 - In front of an entrance to a property
 - Near the brow of a hill

Double yellow lines indicate NO WAITING OR PARKING at any time.



Blue Badge Holders

The blue badge only entitles you to park or wait on double yellow lines where it is safe, at least 15 metres from opposite a junction <u>and providing</u> <u>you are getting out of your car.</u> Please note therefore that blue badge holders should not park on either the double yellow or zigzag lines that run the length of the school site.

The school fully supports all people with disabilities. So if you are reliant on a blue badge holder picking up your child, on their own and in a vehicle, please speak to Mrs Harding so that a special pick up arrangement can be made.



Governor role

Governors provide crucial support and challenge to the leadership of the school with regard to school improvement. Their ultimate aim is to ensure that the school is the best it can be for our pupils. We currently have two vacancies on the governing body. The first is for a Community governor which can include any member of the school community, including parents. The other is for a Foundation governor - this role requires a practising Catholic. The commitment is for one meeting per half term 5-7pm. Primary School admissions

You will be able to apply online using the Citizen's Portal. If you do this the local authority will notify you of the outcome of your application by email on 19 April 2022. This is the most preferable way to make an application.


