Dear Parents / Carers

Welcome back to the Summer term! And it really is beginning to feel like Summer is on its way at last!

We have been busy spring cleaning over the holiday - the classrooms and corridors are looking tidier and brighter. Thank you to all the staff that were involved in this.

We are still waiting for our next visit from HMI which should take place any day now and, as promised, I will let you know a date for a parents update meeting as soon as this has taken place.

This term you will see several changes regarding reading. We are in the process of setting up the Accelerated Reader scheme and further developing the 'Read Write Inc' scheme for phonics and early reading. Both schemes are highly regarded and are scientifically proven to raise the quality and standards of children's reading which will also help to improve their writing. We hope to launch these schemes with the children on the 8th May. From the week beginning the 15th May the library will be open every morning before school so that you can choose books with your child. Over the next few weeks we will also be holding sessions for parents to explain how these schemes work and offer ways that you can help your child develop good reading habits at home. Keep an eye out for the dates!

I hope you like the new look newsletter which has been given a modern facelift for the Summer term! Make sure you look out for it weekly so that you know what is happening in school.
