Covid Update

On 20th October, South West Directors of Public Health recommended that due to the rise in cases in the local area, schools put in place a precautionary and sensible set of measures for the two weeks after half term.

This position was reviewed on 10th November, and a continuation of precautionary measures has been recommended until any further national guidance is received.

In school, we continue with our regular touchpoint cleaning and good ventilation. Please do not send your child to school if they are displaying Covid symptoms.



Christmas Fayre - cancellation

In view of the recommendations from Public Health I have taken the decision to cancel the Christmas Fayre this year on the grounds that there would be a lot of people moving around in a small confined area. I appreciate that this is disappointing but it would enable any Covid infection to spread easily which would be irresponsible given that many of you will be seeing family and elderly relatives over the Christmas period.

Class 1 and Class 2 will, we hope, still be able to perform their Nativity to parents as we will arrange social distanced seating and there will be less movement and contact between people. Face masks will also need to be worn.

Primary School admissions

If your child was born between 1 September 2017 and 31 August 2018 they will be due to start at primary school from September 2022. You will be able to apply for a primary school place between November 2021 and 15 January 2022. You will be able to apply online using the Citizen's Portal. If you do this the local authority will notify you of the outcome of your application by email on 19 April 2022. This is the most preferable way to make an application.
