Year One - Paignton Zoo

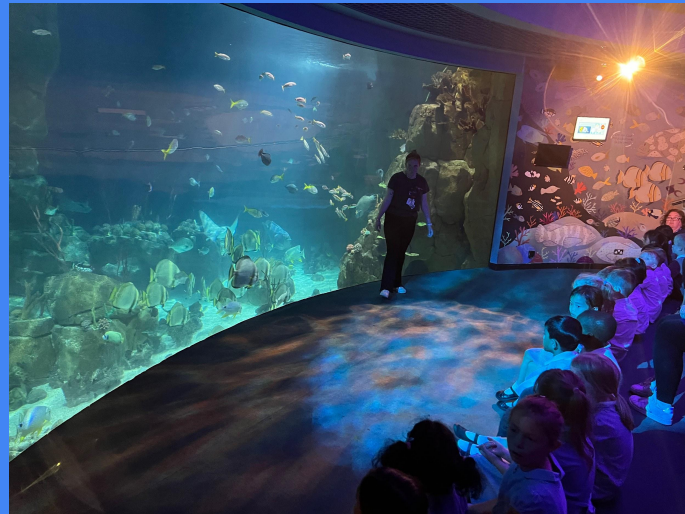
