Attendance Update

Unfortunately our whole school attendance continues to take a downturn and we are sad to learn that our school is now in the bottom 10% of schools nationally.

ATTENDANCE SPECIAL

Welcome to our first attendance

newaletter of the year; the aim is to promote the importance of attendance across the school community. It is really important that we continue to work together to do all we can to prioritise the children's attendance at school so that they can enjoy their learning and socialising with their peers.

You may have heard in the press that there is currently an attendance crisis in the UK.

Overall absence in schools in England has risen more than 50% since 2018, while persistent absence — when pupilism less 10% or more of sessions — has more than doubled, prompting widespread concern and a range of interventions by government innisters.

We have had a visit from our newly appointed Attendance Officer at Torbay Council. The profile of attendance is a key priority for schools and as such they have instructed us to start to implement stricter measures for unauthorised absences of 5 days or more.

Our school is... currently in the bottom

10% of schools across the country for pupil attendance which is very concerning. I have attached a table of pupil numbers in each category for each year group.

The school is also being monitored closely by the Educational Welfare Officer. Support will be aftered to all families where attendance is causing a concern. However where this does not have a positive effect on a child's attendance then we have no option other than to follow the Local Authority's legal route.

Thank you for your donations and for supporting the school. Raffle tickets available every day after school.





Holy Angels After school Club



If you require an After school club place for your child in Holy Angels Pre-school, it is important that you book them in prior to your child arriving at the pre-school door. After School club has a maximum number of children it can accept and there are occasions when it has been full and places are not available. Also, for your child's safety, it is important that Pre-school know to expect your child.

Further to the above, <u>please let the school know if you have booked your child into</u>
<u>After School club at Holy Angels Pre-school.</u> Again, for their safety we need to know where the children are going at the end of each day.
