Incredible Years

The Incredible Years programme is FREE for parents of children aged **3-8 years**. This programme offers a variety of positive strategies to promote communication, improve relationships and reduce the risk of emotional and behavioural difficulties in children and it is great for those parents who need a bit of extra support in finding effective ways to manage behaviour difficulties.

The programme runs weekly for 14 weeks on Friday mornings starting after Easter. The groups will go ahead via TEAMS so you don't need to travel to a venue and can attend from your own home! However, you do need access to IT with sound and video.

This Easter Torbay Council are holding <u>free</u> Healthy Holiday activity clubs for children aged 5 to 16. The activities are being run for children who are in receipt of benefits-related free school meals as part of the government's Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme, which provides free healthy food and exciting events over the school holidays through 2021. The COVID-19 safe fun ranges from sports and crafts to cooking and dance, with special sessions for children with special educational needs, including an online only programme of activities.

Sessions are taking place around Torbay at locations including Brixham Rugby Club, Torre Abbey and Bose Cultural Academy Paignton from the 6 -16 April and each child will be provided with lunch.

School Meals

Payment and ordering of meals is via the Sims Pay system. The cost of a meal is £2.30. One account links to all your children attending the school. Parents should order their child's lunches and make payment in advance (by Saturday for the forthcoming week).

The kitchen manager cooks to order and so late requests for meals cannot always be the child's first choice of meal. If you know your child will be late to school and you have forgotten to pre-order a lunch please contact the school by 9.15a.m. or provide a packed lunch.





Attendance Reminders

If your child is sick please ring on the first day of absence by 9.15 a.m. and every other day thereafter. If you don't do this we will ring you as we are required to check on the welfare of our pupils. You MUST tell us if your child has CoronaVirus symptoms.

Evidence of all medical appointments must be provided.

Please remember to sign your child in at the office if they are brought to school after 9.00a.m.



Wearing of face coverings

Thank you everyone for wearing face masks on the school premises - this is very much appreciated!
