Strep A

It is incredibly sad to hear of the recent deaths of young children from Group A Streptococcus infections. It is a worry for all of us as parents but we should remind ourselves that it remains very rare for there to be complications and can usually be treated with antibiotics. The Department of Education states that all children are still required to attend school.

We are following the guidance to reduce the transmission of infection as follows:

- Children with raised temperatures should not attend school
- Children should exercise good hand and respiratory hygiene.

Lunches must be ordered by 8.15 on the day, but can be ordered in advance.


