I am pleased to tell you that we have booked a Year 4 residential trip to Buckfast Abbey for Wednesday 19th - Friday 21st June. The trip offers an enjoyable and intensely exciting learning experience as well as the opportunity to develop each child's independence and self-organisational skills. We do hope that your child will be able to join us.

We have done our best to keep the cost of the trip as low as possible at **£100.00**. This includes 2 nights accommodation, transport to and from the venue, meals (children will need to bring a packed lunch on the first day) and all activities and materials. We are required to confirm numbers by Friday 14th June therefore all payments must be made in full by that date. Payments can be made by cheque (made payable to Plymouth CAST) or cash and in instalments. These should be sent in to school in a sealed envelope clearly marked 'Buckfast Abbey Y4' with your child's name. A payment card will be provided to assist you in keeping track of how much you have paid.
