Parents of Reception and Year 1 children must stay on the premises. Snacks and drinks will be available to purchase.





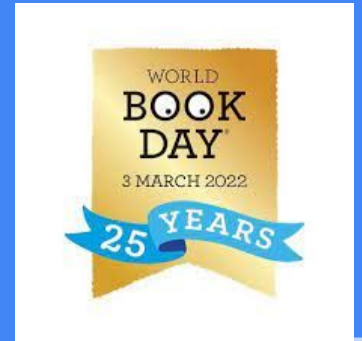

Face coverings no longer need to be worn on the playground.





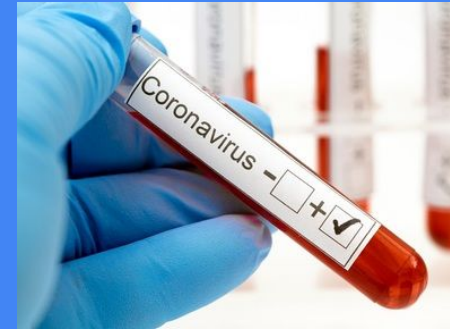
