# School Meals

Payment and ordering of meals is via the Sims Pay system (this is the system that parents have previously used to pay for trips). The cost of a meal is £2.30 per meal.One account links to all your children attending the school. Parents should order their child's lunches and make payment by Saturday for the forthcoming week (Please note we currently have a problem with the ordering system so children are ordering in class for now).

The kitchen manager cooks to order and so late requests for meals cannot always be the child's first choice of meal. If you know your child will be late to school and you have forgotten to pre-order a lunch please contact the school by 9.30a.m. or provide a packed lunch.





#### **Flu Vaccinations**

Children in Reception to Year 6 from September 2020 are eligible for a Free Nasal Childhood Flu Vaccination in the Autumn term. These will be administered adhering to all up to date Infection Control, PPE and social distancing guidance at the time.

We are expecting demand to be high and therefore we urge you to follow the link to consent to your child's vaccination now. Even if you do not want your child to receive this vaccination, please complete the consent form stating "no" consent. # **Incredible Years**

Incredible Years is a FREE parenting programme which is being offered to local families by South West Family Values.

The programme provides strategies which build positive relationships and guides parents to set clear and consistent boundaries before working through appropriate behaviour management strategies.

The course is 14 weeks long and is a great opportunity for parents/carers who are looking to make positive changes to their parenting styles. The programme can help you if you are struggling with boundaries, finding your child challenging or feeling that you can't control your child's behaviour.

The group uses a combination of skills practice, watching recorded clips, home activity, discussions and trouble shooting to support a variety of learning styles. The next group will commence in October 2020 and, due to the COVID crisis, will be run remotely for the first time – therefore parents/carers will need access to suitable IT to enable them to attend the group via Zoom or Teams.




