


# What we did last Week!

#### What is the research about?

This research is part of my doctoral studies in Education, Child and Community Psychology at the University of Exeter. I aim to explore how parents support their children with maths at home.

# Holy Angels After school Club



If you require an After school club place for your child in Holy Angels Pre-school, it is important that you book them in prior to your child arriving at the pre-school door.
