Apply online from 1 November 2022 for September 2023 admissions. You must apply by 15 January 2023. If you apply after 15 January your application will be considered as late and may be at a disadvantage.

Lunches must be ordered by 8.15 on the day, but can be ordered in advance for the whole term.


