Travelling to School Safely - advice

If you live a short distance from school or college, walk, cycle or scoot to and from school wherever it is possible and safe to do so.

Avoid sharing a car with anyone outside of your household or support bubble.

If you are using public transport to get to school or college, plan ahead and allow more time for your journey. When you are travelling by public or dedicated school transport, don't forget to:

- wear a face covering (unless you are exempt, including if you are aged 11 and under). It is important you wear them for the entirety of your journey, including inside a bus or train station
- social distance where possible
- wash or sanitise your hands regularly
- be considerate to fellow passengers and staff.



Supporting Families with Fuel Costs

Citizens Advice Devon will be distributing £55,000 on behalf of Torbay Council for additional support using the Covid Winter Grants Scheme. The funding is expected to support up to 600 households in food and fuel need.

Citizens Advice East Devon is leading on this Scheme on behalf of Citizens Advice in Devon/Torbay. In addition to offering families the normal support to address underlying issues, families may now be eligible to receive a one-off payment of £77 per household towards their fuel needs from the Covid Winter Grants Scheme. Payments can be in the form of vouchers, or directly onto smart meter account or online billing account.

On receipt of a referral, one of the team at Citizens Advice East Devon will look at the case details, cross reference the client to see if they have already claimed support, and make contact if they are eligible for help.

School Meals

Payment and ordering of meals is via the Sims Pay system . The cost of a meal is £2.30. One account links to all your children attending the school. Parents should order their child's lunches and make payment in advance (by Saturday for the forthcoming week).

The kitchen manager cooks to order and so late requests for meals cannot always be the child's first choice of meal. <u>If you know your child will be late to</u> <u>school and you have forgotten to pre-order a lunch please contact the school</u> <u>by 9.15a.m. or provide a packed lunch.</u>





Attendance Reminders

If your child is sick please ring on the first day of absence by 9.15 a.m. and every other day thereafter. If you don't do this we will ring you as we are required to check on the welfare of our pupils. You MUST tell us if your child has CoronaVirus symptoms.

Evidence of all medical appointments must be provided.

Please remember to sign your child in at the office if they are brought to school after 9.00a.m.



Wearing of face coverings

Thank you everyone for wearing face masks on the school premises - this is very much appreciated!
