Applications received after this date will be classed as late and will not be dealt with until after the allocation date of 19th April 2022. Some schools will then be full. <u>Please apply online before the 15th January using the Citizen's Portal.</u> If you do this the local authority will notify you of the outcome of your application by email on 19 April 2022. This is the most preferable way to make an application.


