Goodbye Mrs Pethard

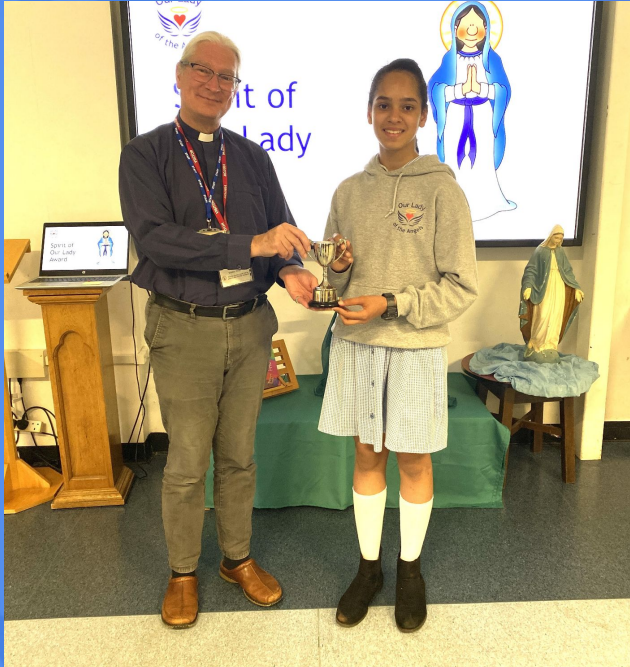


Sadly we have to say goodbye to Mrs Pethard at the end of this term.

A big thank you to Mrs Hill and Miss Holt for running the club.

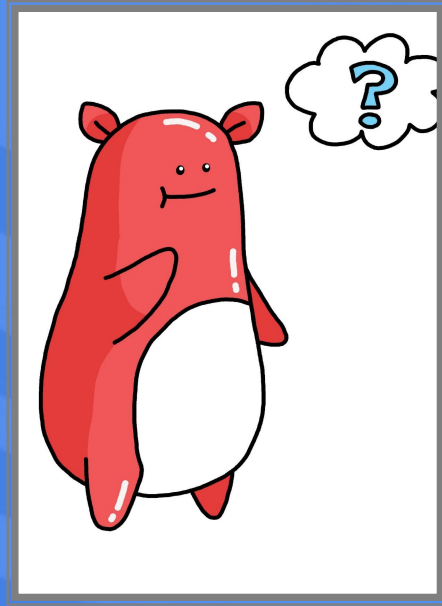
