Dear Parents and Carers,

Y5 Trip to Torquay Museum - Wednesday 8th November

This term we have been learning about the Ancient Egyptian civilization. We have been looking at the structure of their society, daily life and the role of Pharaohs, the importance of the River Nile as well as finding out about Canopic jars for our art project. We have a wonderful opportunity to go to Torquay museum who, in addition to their usual exhibits, have a travelling Egyptian exhibition and are running an Egyptian workshop.

The trip will take place within the normal school day on Wednesday 8th November. We plan to leave school at 9.30am and will return in time for the end of the school day. We are asking parents for a **voluntary donation** of £12.84 to cover the cost of this trip. Torquay Museum charges £8.00 per child and the coach will cost £4.84 per child. Please note that no parent is asked to subsidise another child. <u>Please sign in to your ParentPay account and make payment.</u>

The school will fund 50% of all children who are in receipt of free school meals (benefit related) therefore children in receipt of free school meals need only pay £6.00.

This is a voluntary contribution, however if we do not receive enough contributions we will have no alternative but to cancel the trip.

All visits are costed in advance and based on the total number of pupils due to attend and the relevant travel. In the unfortunate situation that your child cannot attend on the day of the visit due to absence, then regrettably the school is not in the position to offer any refund.

On the day of the trip the children will need to wear their school uniform and a coat. They will also need to bring a drink and a packed lunch.

The kitchen can offer a free packed lunch to those in receipt of free school meals. If you would like to take up this option please complete the attached form.
