Household Support Fund



Are you struggling with the cost of living but not on benefits? Help is available through the Household Support Fund.

Residents can make two applications for funding between now and March – one between April and September, and another between October and March.

Households not receiving a welfare benefit can receive between £250 and £500, depending on the size of your household. Households receiving a welfare benefit can receive £150.

Parents must order and pay for school dinners in advance via ParentPay. <u>Please note that parents whose children are entitled to Free school meals or universal infant free school meals must also order their children's lunches in advance.</u>

School dinners must be ordered by midnight (preferable a week in advance).
